

MEMBERSHIP LEVELS

- Regular Membership (\$50) Paid annually and expires at the end of each fiscal year.
- Lifetime Membership (\$1000) May be paid in full or in installments within a period not to exceed five (5) years. Once paid in full, Lifetime Membership does not expire.
- Recent Alumnae Membership (\$25) For alumnae whose class has not celebrated its first (5-year) reunion. Paid annually and expires at the end of the fiscal year.
- New Graduate (Free) The most recent graduating class will receive a one-year complimentary membership.


